Dear Freshman:

Welcome to Canyon High School! We sincerely hope that the next four years will be a rewarding experience for you. **Classes begin on Thursday, August 14th.** Please read the following information carefully to get started.

Your first big event will take place on **Friday, August 1st from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.** Please come to the **Library** for the “**Cowboy Round-up**”. There will be refreshments available as we introduce you to the CARE student counselors who will lead you through the Registration process the following week. You will be divided into groups for interactive games, a tour of the campus, and tips on how to succeed your freshman year.

On **Thursday, August 7th**, you will come to the front circle driveway, located next to the administration building, for Registration. **Please arrive at Registration at your scheduled appointment time**, which you can find in the grid below. CARE Student Counselors will be here to help you through registration. At Registration, you will receive your schedule of classes for the first semester, have your yearbook picture taken, get your Canyon ID card, and have an opportunity to purchase a yearbook, ASB card, PE clothes, adult ASB card (for your parents and adult relatives), and youth ASB card (for younger siblings). You are strongly encouraged to buy an ASB card, as it will save you many dollars over the course of the year. **Fill out and bring the enclosed order form, with payment, to Registration** at the following time according to your birthday:

We anticipate that the entire Registration process will take approximately an hour and a half. Students can come alone with their emergency cards and checks already prepared, or with a parent to help (optional). **Students will only be given their class schedule when they present two signed emergency cards, completely filled out (both sides!)** In case of emergency (earthquake, fire, etc.) students can only be released to adults whose names appear on the emergency card. If you cannot attend your Registration date and time listed above, you'll need to come to **Make-up Registration** on **Friday, August 8th from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m.** If you still cannot attend that date, you will be required to arrive early on the first day of school, Thursday, August 14th to pick up your schedule of classes between 6:30 and 7:45 a.m.

During Registration, the Counseling Office will be open for ninth graders who need to change their schedule to drop an athletic team or to change a class because they lack the necessary skills. Please do not request a teacher change or a change of elective, as we cannot accommodate these requests during registration.

Lockers are assigned on a very limited basis, and will be given only to students with special needs. Students with a crucial need for a locker may sign up for one in the health office during the first week of school.

Included in this mailing, you will also find information on school photographs. If you wish to purchase photos, please bring cash or a check made out to the photographer, “**RG Productions**.” You may only order pictures at the time they are taken. Make-up photos for absent students will be taken during Make-up Registration.
